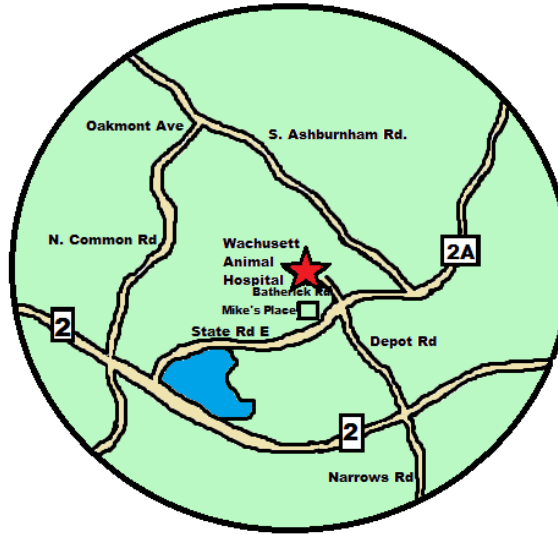

DIRECTIONS

From The West:

Take Rt. 2 East to exit 25, then take Rt. 2A East for 1.8 miles. Take a left at the General Store onto Batherick Rd. Go up the hill and stay to the right into the business park; Wachusett Animal Hospital and Pet Retreat will be on the right.

From The East:

Take Rt. 2 West to exit 27, then take a right at the end of the ramp onto Depot Rd. Continue on Depot Rd until you come to a stop sign, go straight through the stop sign onto Batherick Rd, go up the hill and stay to the right into the business park; Wachusett Animal Hospital and Pet Retreat will be on the right.

EMERGENCY*

- Veterinarian on-call 24 hours a day
- ICU area with oxygen cages, state-of-the-art diagnostic equipment, an extremely knowledgeable and caring team
- In house laboratory for complete blood counts, blood chemistry, cytology, blood gas and coagulation testing, urinalyses
- Blood Transfusions/Blood Bank Program

SURGERY

Procedures performed include:

- Routine spays and neuters
- Gastrointestinal surgeries (i.e. foreign bodies)
- C-sections
- Mass removals
- Splenectomies, and more
- Visiting surgeon for orthopedic procedures



IMAGING

- Cutting edge digital X-Ray allows us to rapidly evaluate internal problems and email films to a specialist or referral facility
- In house ultrasound machine for emergency patients
- Visiting board-certified emergency/critical care specialist for complete abdominal and cardiac ultrasounds

HOSPITALIZATION

Large recovery wards with dedicated nursing staff

- Oxygen therapy for patients with respiratory distress
- Accessible staff with frequent updates from your pets' veterinarian
- Isolation ward for patients with infectious diseases complete with separate entrance and HVAC system to prevent disease transmission
- Chemotherapy options for cancer patients



ANESTHESIA

- Continuous anesthetic monitoring by a designated technician
- Sevoflurane anesthetic gas - the safest in the industry. This gas is more rapidly eliminated from the system so your pet wakes up faster and more smoothly
- A vital signs monitor allows us to monitor heart rate, blood pressure, oxygenation, EKG and core body temperature
- Heated surgical table
- IV catheters and fluids keep patients hydrated during and after their procedure
- Pre-anesthetic blood testing

DENTISTRY

- Dental check-ups can help protect your pet from dental disease, which can cause loose teeth and chronic pain
- Patients are anesthetized for dental scaling and polishing
- A full oral exam identifies any loose or diseased teeth that need treatment
- Digital dental X-Rays evaluate broken and diseased teeth, as well as oral tumors
